# WASTE DISCHARGE INFORMATION FOR COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND MULTIFAMILY DWELLINGS THAT WILL UTILIZE AN ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted Order 01-031 to require general waste discharge requirements for commercial facilities and multifamily dwelling units that utilize subsurface sewage disposal systems. Wastewater generated by these projects may be subject to waste discharge requirements. Before the Environmental Health Division can approve an application to install, replace, repair or certify an onsite wastewater treatment system, the applicant must first obtain from the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board one of the following documents:

1. Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for the proposed discharge; or,
2. A determination that the proposed discharge is subject to General Waste Discharge Requirements from the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board; or,
3. The Waste Discharge Requirements for the proposed discharge; or,
4. Written authorization from the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board for the Ventura County Environmental Health Division to issue appropriate permits.
