

Prospective Applicant's Supplemental Checklist for Determining Eligibility for a Rescission/Re-entry of an LCA Contract

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The purpose of this checklist is to assist prospective applicants in determining if their property is eligible for a rescission of an existing agricultural LCA contract and re-entry into one or more new 10-year or 20-year agricultural LCA contracts. A rescission/reentry may be used if the landowner wishes to add non-contracted land to an existing contract, transfer contracted land from one type of contract to another, or where property under an existing contract is subdivided, adjusted, or merged, even if the outer boundary of the existing contact remains unchanged. Note at that the eligibility requirements listed below are in addition to those for new LCA contracts, and that additional eligibility checklists are available for other specific contract application elements such as those involving Lot Line Adjustments.

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Tip: If the proposed rescission/re-entry involves the exchange of land between properties that are not all already subject to an LCA contract, make sure that either equal amounts of land are exchanged or the LCA contracted property acquires more land than the non-contracted property.
